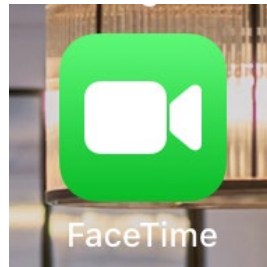
How to make a video call - FaceTime



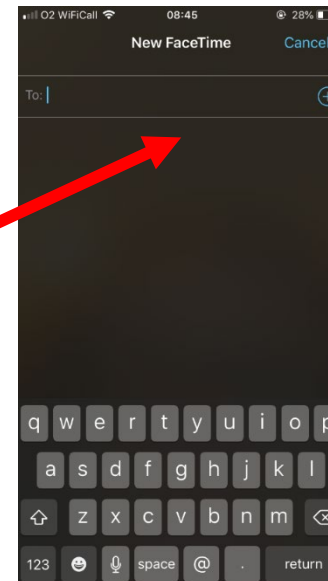
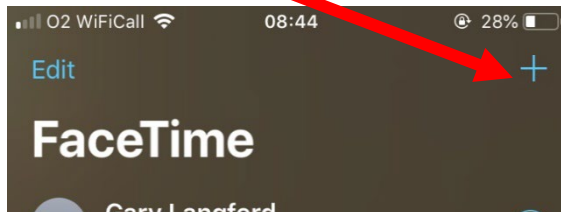
On your iPhone or iPad

Please note: FaceTime only works on Apple products so you must have an iPhone or iPad.

1. To start a call, please open the app. This is probably already on your homescreen because it's one of Apple's default apps. If it isn't then you will have to download it from the App store.



2. Click on the person's name in the list or search for them using '+' which is how to activate the search function.

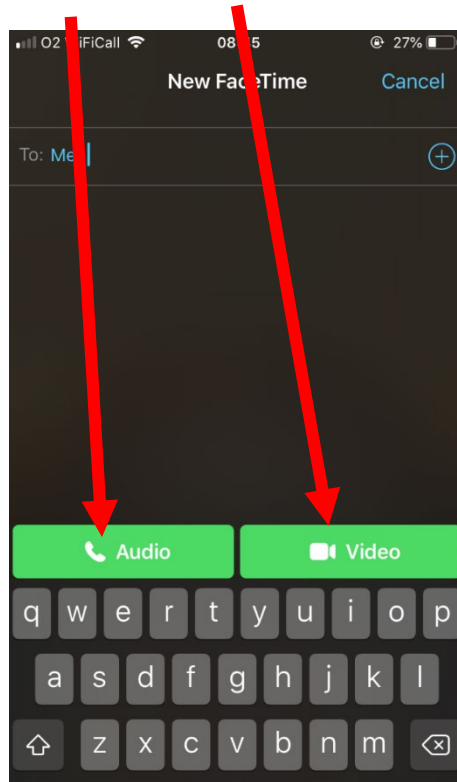

3. Once you've clicked on the name of the person you would like to speak to there will be two options audio or video. Click the type of call you would like to make.

4. Once you are in the call if you pull the menu upwards from the bottom using the bar (A) then you will be able to see all the different options available:

- turn the camera on or off (B)
- mute or unmute your microphone (C)
- flip the camera around so that you can show what's in front of you instead of your face (D)
- end the call (E)
- add other people into the conversations (F)
